

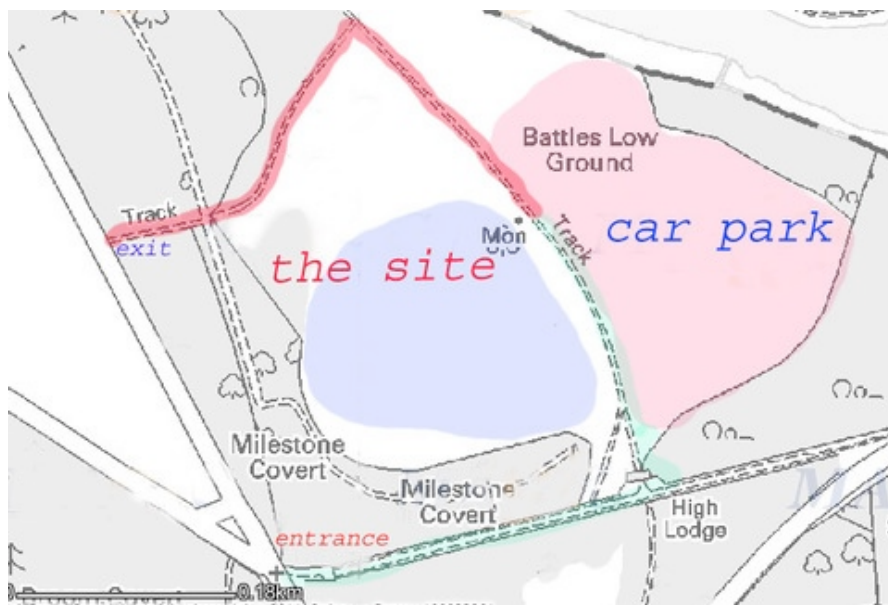
IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR 2011

Dear Stallholder,

There is a major change to The Fair this year in that it has moved to a new venue – **a beautiful part of the Henham estate on the A12.** We are very excited about this new venue and feel sure that you will be too. Here we can accommodate more stalls, more people and more music while still retaining the unique flavour of our beloved Greenpeace Fair.

There is no charge for car parking, unless you wish to keep your vehicle next to your pitch, in which case this is £10 per vehicle.

The stall-booking fee for a single or double pitch will permit you to bring ONE vehicle to the Fair. If you are not keeping your vehicle as part of your stall, it will need to be parked in a special area further down the field.



Once again, the fair will take place as a one-day event on Sunday 4 September 2011, with strictly no overnight camping. There will be no access to the fair site until 7:00 am on Sunday. Please do not try to arrange to come earlier, as entrances will be blocked. General admission will not start until 10:45am.

Payment: Please send payment with the attached form and an s.a.e. as soon as possible, to the relevant person at the top of the form. (Either Alice for non-food stalls or Marion for food stalls). All stallholders must pay for their stall, and any extra vehicle passes IN ADVANCE. This saves time on the gate, and saves volunteers the time-consuming bother of chasing it up later in the day. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Again this year there will be a surcharge on the fee for late bookings:

*****ANY BOOKING RECEIVED AFTER 14th AUGUST 2011 (3 weeks before the fair) WILL BE SUBJECT TO AN EXTRA £10 ON TOP OF THE FEE YOU WOULD BE CHARGED FOR THE SPACE YOU WANT.*****

This is to reduce the amount of last-minute work, so please ensure you return your booking to us in good time!

We hope you will continue to support Greenpeace by booking a stall at our event, and we look forward to seeing you at Henham on the day – let's hope the weather is kind to us!

We shall be holding our Greenpeace Fair on Sunday 4th September 2011 at the new venue of Henham, nr. Wangford from 11am to midnight. If you would like to have a stall, please complete the form below and return it as soon as possible, with payment by cheque, to Alice or Marion as applicable, at the appropriate address above.

- Please enclose an S.A.E. with your form
- Booked and paid stallholders need to arrive between 7am and 9:30am and leave no earlier than 5pm
- Your vehicle should be off the site before 10am unless it is part of your stall (see stall costs, below).
- Stalls cannot be set up before Sunday.
- Your booking will be confirmed by telephone or e-mail. Please give all these details clearly.
- One week before the date of the Fair, you will be sent a VEHICLE PASS. This will need to be clearly displayed on your vehicle windscreen - failure to do so may result in long delays.
- Please no generators, and absolutely NO CAMPING

Stall costs:

- £30 for a 4m spread (Charities £20), £50 for an 8m spread.
- Stalls larger than 8m please contact Alice or Marion as appropriate, before sending in the form.
- £10 per blanket up to 2m x 1.5m (no gazebo), + normal entry charge.
- £10 for a vehicle kept ON SITE (If you need extra vehicle offsite, let us know on tear-off form)
- Gazebos and any vehicles used as part of your stall are counted as part of your pitch size
- Please PAY IN ADVANCE (including any extra vehicles), and make cheques payable to Waveney Greenpeace (see letter over)

Foodstalls: Please see attached guidelines.

The Waveney Greenpeace group organises the fair every year. ALL profits go to central Greenpeace where they are used exclusively to fund actions and campaigns to protect the environment. We are proud of our fair and of the many thousands of pounds we have raised over the years. We are all volunteers and work for months to ensure the fair day is a great event, and is as environmentally friendly as possible. Please help us by

- Using eco-friendly packaging
- Keeping any dogs strictly on leads at all times
